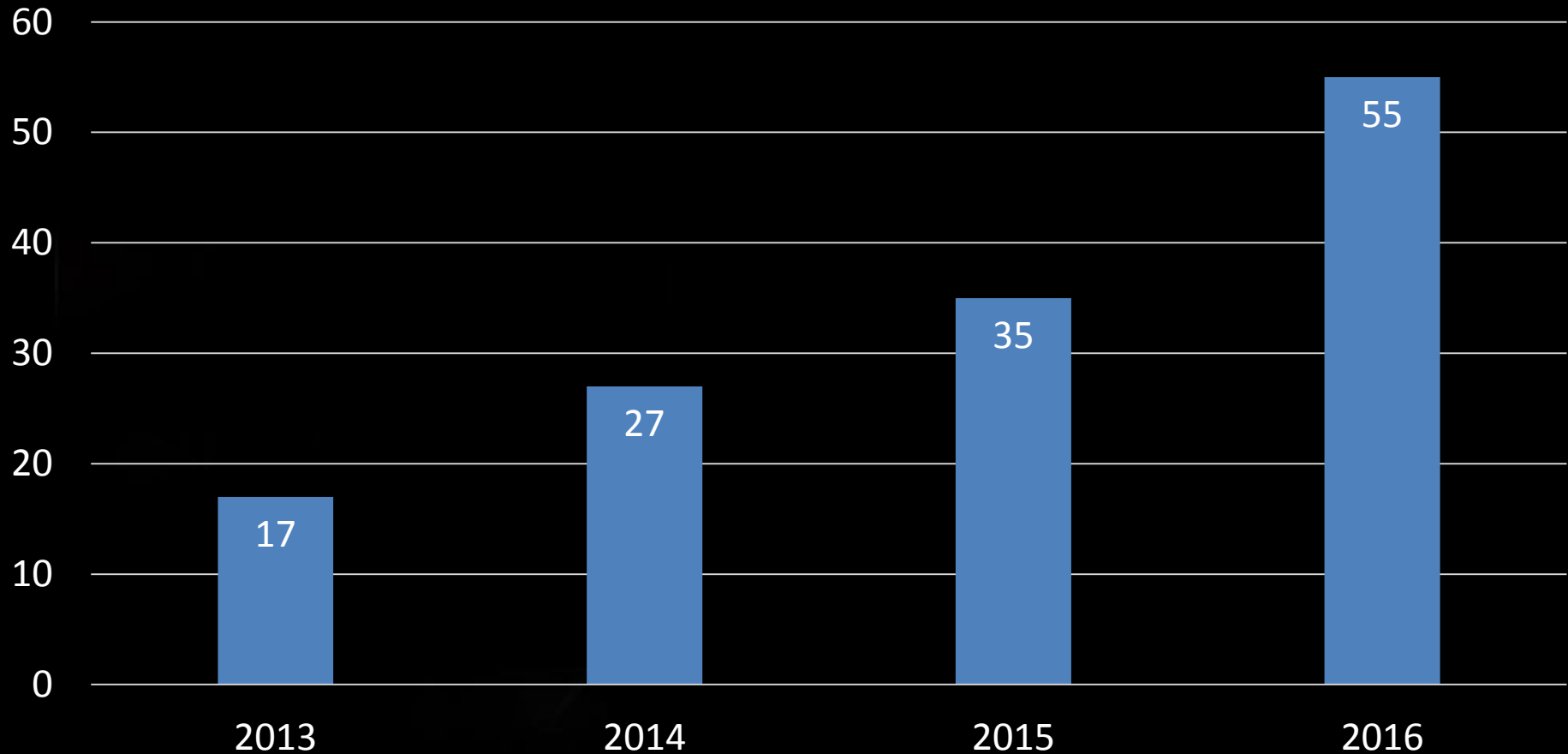

Public Relations and Collaboration with Other Organizations

- Major Achievements
 - Discussing with the NATA Foundation a means by which money can be donated to ATOAC thru the Foundation.
 - Proposed to co-sponsor the Journal of Athletic Training's (JAT) session at the 2017 NATA Annual Meeting
 - JAT offered table space at their Expo booth for an ATOAC promotional sign and handouts.
 - Discussed with the NATA convention programming committee how to increase OA-related content across convention platforms at the 2018 NATA Annual Meeting (with Work Group 4).
- In the Future
 - Explore how NATA is (or is not) meeting it's commitment to COAMI, and how ATOAC may work with the NATA to meet this commitment regarding OA related education.

- Major Achievements
 - First ATOAC Webinar (on YouTube) – March 2016

 - Initial multicenter feasibility study of ATOAC members

- Major Achievements
 - Development of a focused ATOAC meeting agenda for 2016
 - Securing a wide range of speakers with a variety of interests and experience levels for the ATOAC meeting
 - Thanks to John Goetschius - improvements the ATOAC website
- In the Future
 - We anticipate developing a meeting that improves upon feedback from this year's meeting
 - We will seek funding for the next meeting
 - We anticipate assisting the Executive Committee in developing programming for the NATA Annual Symposium and Expo for 2017 and 2018 meetings (with Work Group 1)



Finance Task Force

- Major Achievements
 - ATOAC Executive Committee chartered the ATOAC Finance Task Force
 - Identified revenue needs and potential revenue sources (dues, webinar fees, meeting fees, grants, crowd funding, industry).
 - Surveyed membership on potential revenue sources
 - Briefed ATOAC Executive Committee on progress
 - Investigated applying for 501(c)(3) Tax-exempt status
 - Reached out to the NATA-REF as potential short or long term solution and partner
- In the Future
 - Finalize mechanism for ATOAC finances (revenue and expenditures)
 - ATOAC Executive Committee establish TF priorities
